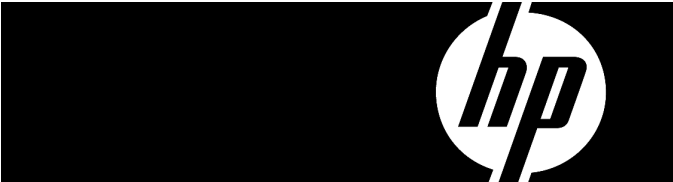

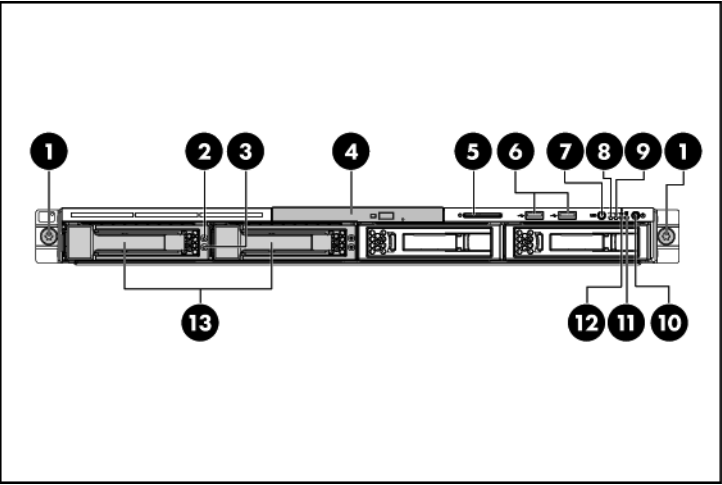

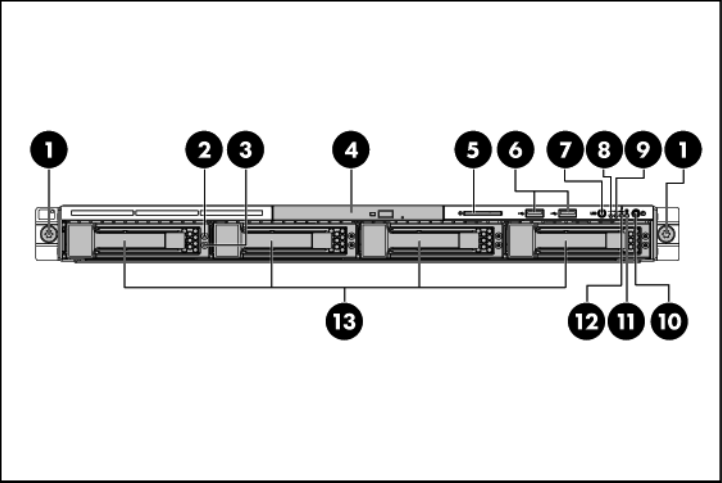

Figure 1 Front Panel Components / 2 3.5" HDD Hot-plug HDD Model



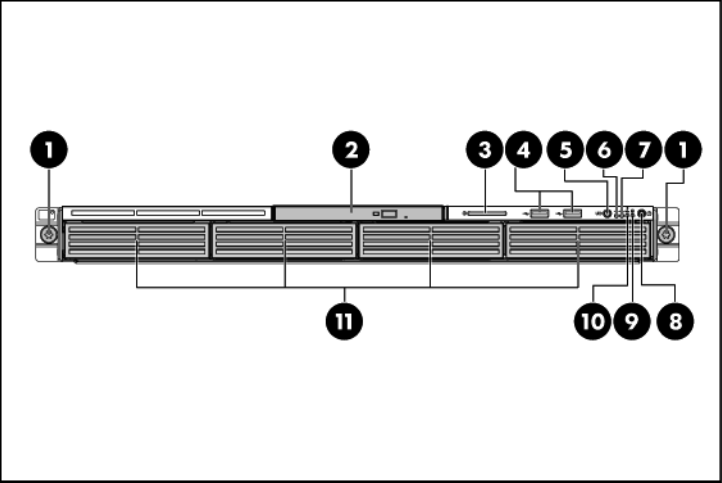

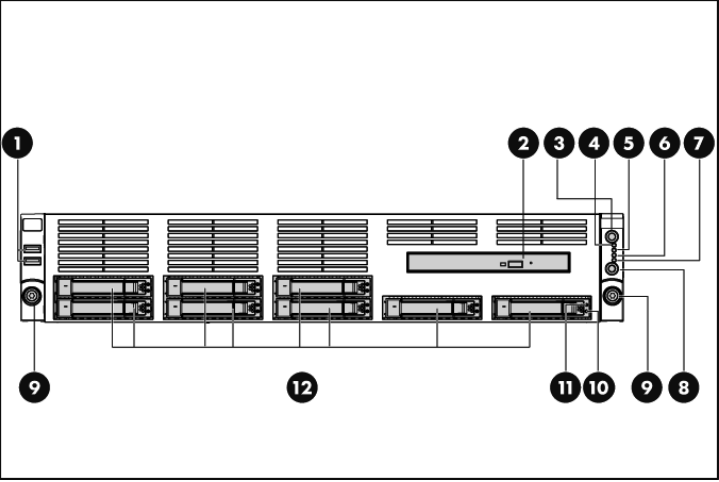
Figure 3 Front Panel Components / 4 3.5" HDD Non-hot-plug Model

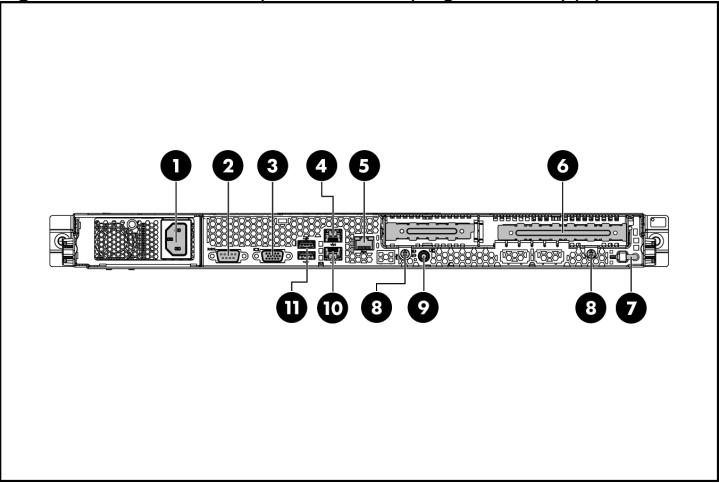
Figure 4 Front Panel Components / 8 2.5" HDD Hot-plug Model

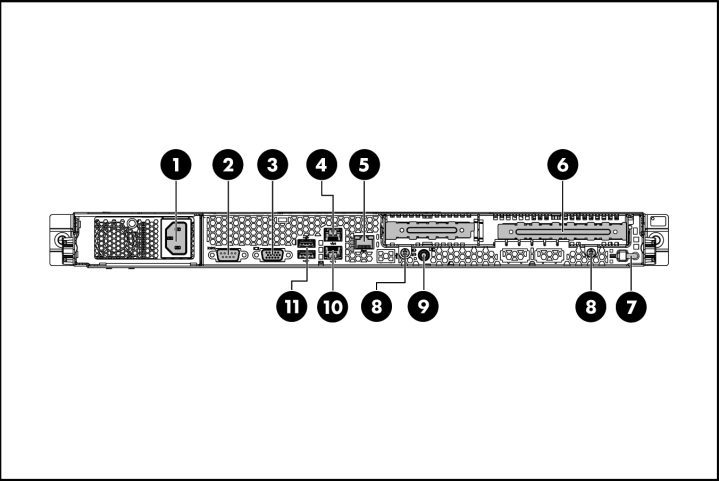

Figure 6 Rear Panel Components / Non-hot-plug Power Supply Model



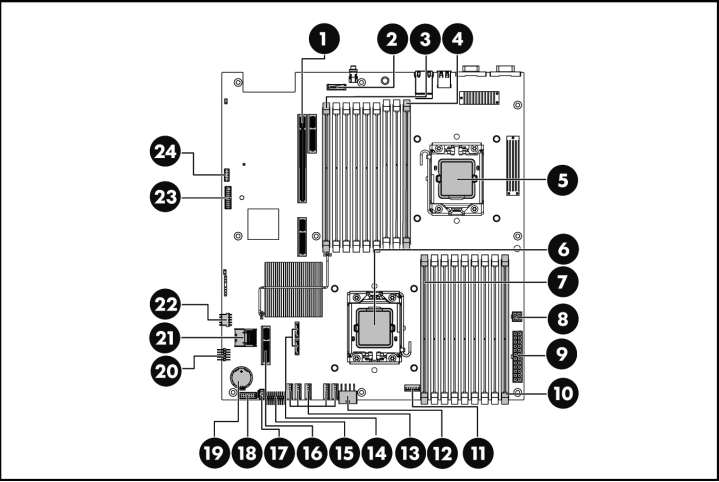

Server configuration overview

The steps listed below give an overview of the necessary setup procedures for preparing the HP ProLiant DL160 G6 Server for operation:

- Connect the AC power cord and peripheral devices.
- Power on the server.
- Press “F10” to enter BIOS setup.
- Note the server BIOS version.
- Verify the server BIOS version against the latest BIOS version listed for this server.
- If you do not have the latest BIOS, update the BIOS now. Refer to the *HP ProLiant DL160 G6 Server Maintenance and Service Guide*.
- Install a supported operating system of your choice. For detailed procedures, refer to the documentation provided by the operating system vendor.

Pre- and post-installation procedures

When installing additional options in your HP ProLiant DL160 G6 Server, observe the following procedures:

Pre-installation procedures

- Turn off the server and all the peripherals connected to it.
- Disconnect the AC power cord from the power supply cable socket located on the server rear panel to reduce the risk of electrical shock.
- If the server is installed in a rack, remove the server and place it on a flat surface.
- Remove the top cover by following the procedure described later in the “Opening the server” section.

Post-installation procedures

- Be sure all components are installed according to the described step-by-step instructions.
- Check to make sure you have not left loose tools or parts inside the server.
- Reinstall the PCI cage, air baffle, peripherals, and system cables that you have removed.
- Reinstall the top cover.
- Reinstall the server into the rack.
- Connect all external cables and the AC power cord to the system.
- Press the power button on the front panel to turn on the server.

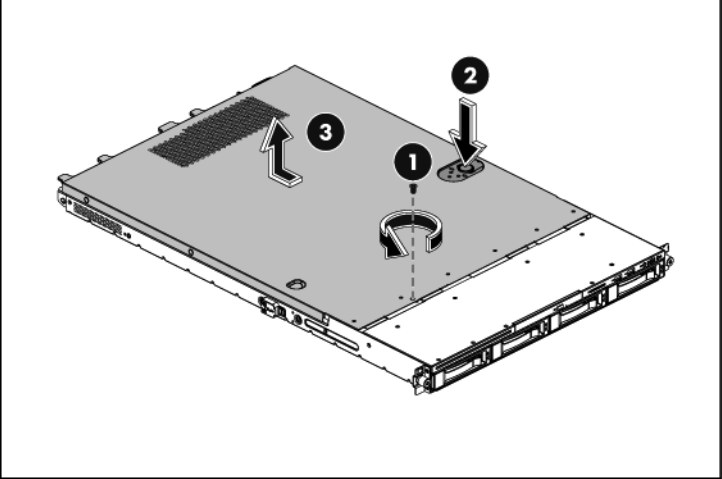
Opening the server

The top cover is removable. You need to remove the top cover before you can remove or replace a server component.

To remove the top cover:

- Loosen the screw on the top cover with a T-10 wrench.
- Press the latch on the top cover.
- Slide the cover toward the rear of the server and then lift the top cover to remove it from the chassis. Lift the top cover away from the chassis.

Installing a hard drive

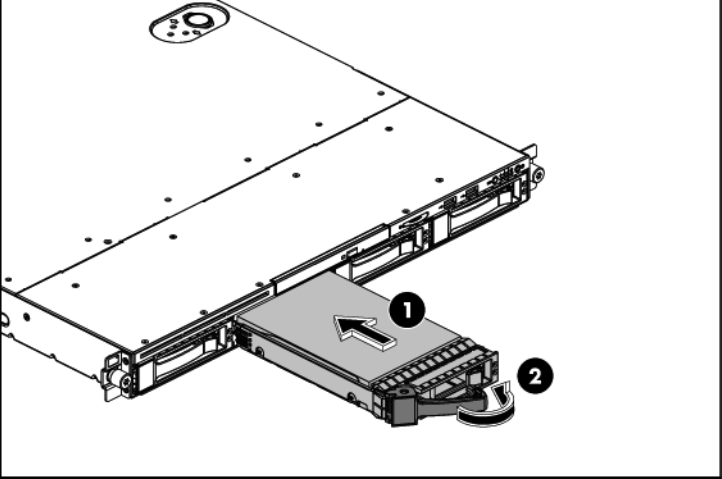
The drive bays on the front panel can accommodate two hot-plug hard drives, four hot-plug hard drives, or four non-hot-plug hard drives. You can install either SAS hard drives or SATA hard drives in the server.

CAUTION: Drives can be damaged by static electricity. Before handling drives, touch an unpainted metal surface to discharge static electricity.

To install the hot-plug hard drive:

1. Push the hard drive assembly into the drive bay until it stops.
2. Press the hard drive carrier latch inward until it clicks.

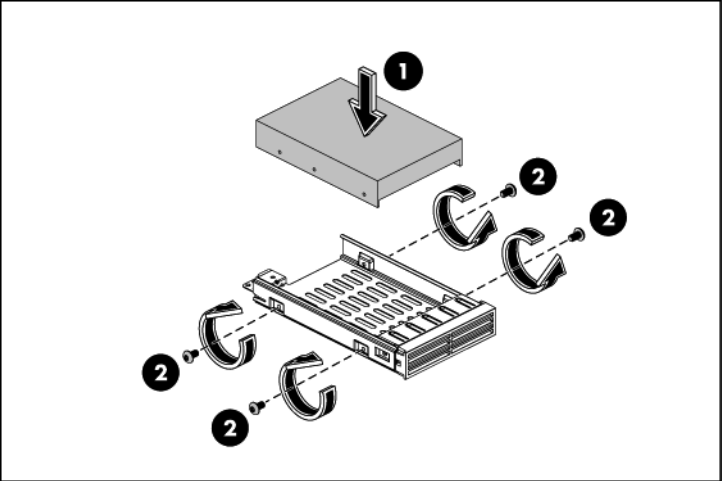
Figure 9 Installing the Hot-plug Drive



To install the non-hot-plug hard drive:

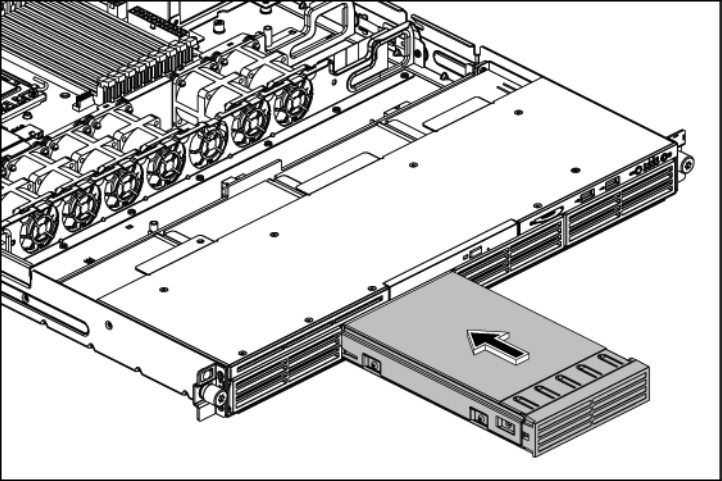
1. Put the non-hot-plug hard drive disk into the carrier.
2. Fasten the hard drive to the carrier using the screws (two on each side).

Figure 10 Installing the Non-hot-plug Hard Drive into the Carrier



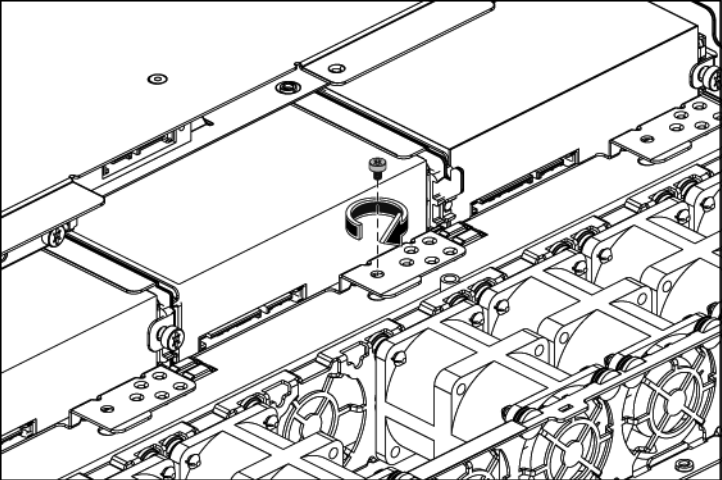
3. Remove the hard drive blank from front of system if installed.
4. Push the hard drive assembly into the drive bay until it stops.

5. Fasten the screw with the T-10/T-15 wrench provided to secure the hard drive to the chassis.

Figure 12 Fastening the Screw

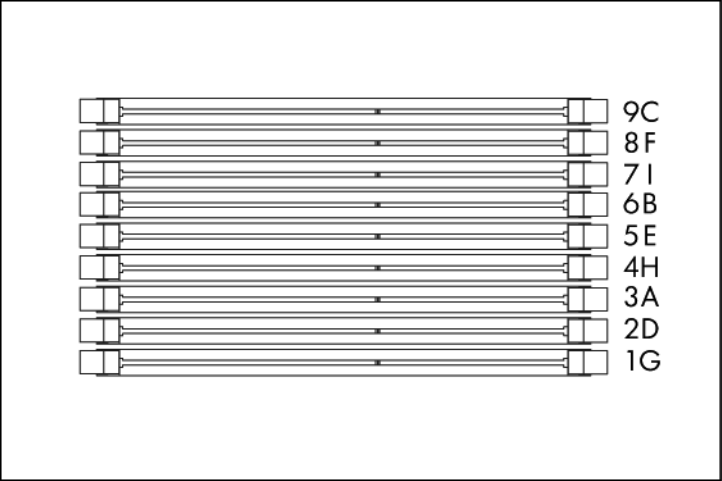


6. Connect the cabling from the SAS connector on the system board to the drives using the cables provided.

Installing a memory module

- Installation guide for 1P configuration:
 - Follow the sequence of 3A, 6B, 9C, 2D, 5E, 8F, 1G, 4H, and 7I for the corresponding processor when installing the memory.
- Installation guide for 2P configuration:
 - Follow the sequence of 3A, 6B, 9C, 2D, 5E, 8F, 1G, 4H, and 7I for the corresponding processor when installing the memory.
 - Install at least one memory DIMM for each processor.
 - The memory quantity installed for each processor can be different.

Figure 13 DIMM Population



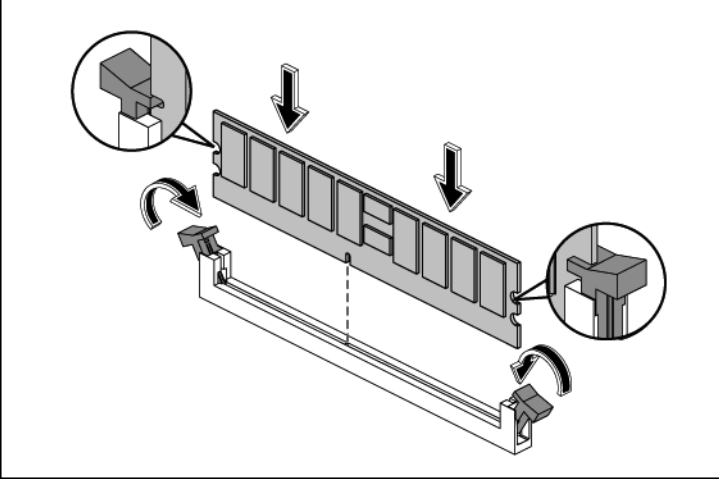
CAUTION: DIMMs can be damaged by improper handling. Always use an anti-static wrist strap and grounding mat, and discharge static electricity before touching DIMMs.

NOTE: Refer to "System board components" in this document for the DIMM locations.

To install the memory module:

1. Align the notch on the bottom edge of the memory module with the keyed surface of the DIMM slot and then fully press the memory module into the slot until the holding clips snap back in place.

CAUTION: DIMM slots are structured to ensure proper installation. If you insert a DIMM but it does not fit easily into the slot, you may have inserted it incorrectly. Reverse the orientation of the DIMM and insert it again.

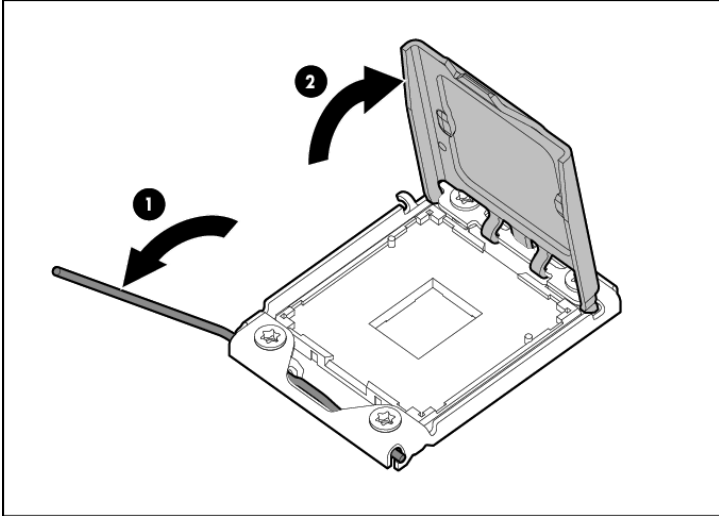
Installing a processor

CAUTION: If upgrading the system to 130W processors, system fan configuration must be updated to ensure proper system thermal performance. Fan configurations are detailed in the server Maintenance and Service Guide, available from the HP website at <http://www.hp.com/>.

To install the processor:

- CAUTION:** Failure to completely open the processor locking lever prevents the processor from seating during installation, leading to hardware damage.
1. Open the processor locking lever and the processor socket retaining bracket. **Do not remove the processor socket cover.**

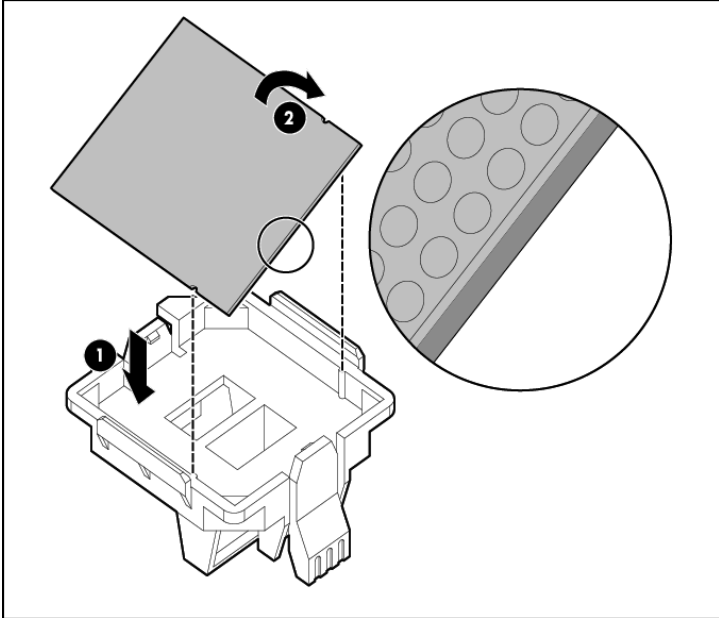
Figure 15 Opening the lever and bracket



IMPORTANT: Be sure the processor remains inside the processor installation tool.

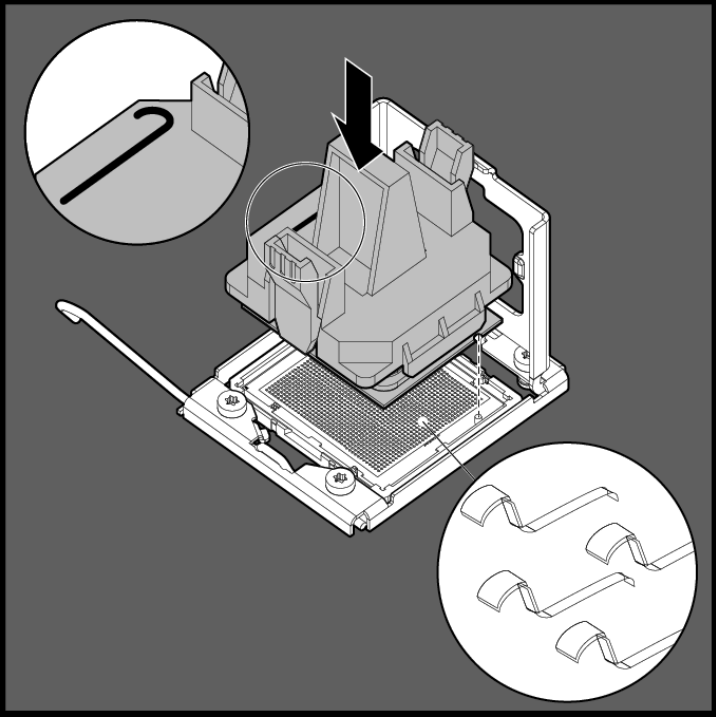
2. If the processor has separated from the installation tool, carefully re-insert the processor in the tool. Handle the processor by the edges only, and do not touch the bottom of the processor, especially the contact area.

3. Align the processor installation tool with the socket, and then install the processor. **THE PINS ON THE SYSTEM BOARD ARE VERY FRAGILE AND EASILY DAMAGED.**

Figure 17 Installing the processor

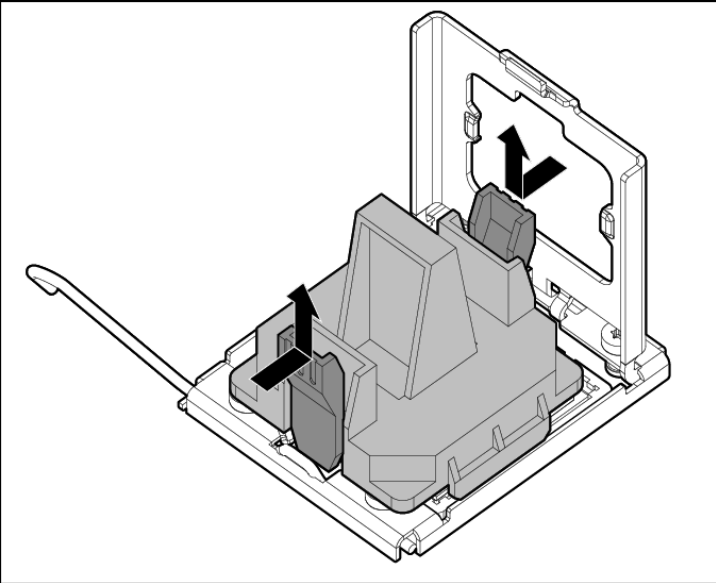


CAUTION: THE PINS ON THE SYSTEM BOARD ARE VERY FRAGILE AND EASILY DAMAGED. To avoid damage to the system board:

- Never install or remove a processor without using the processor installation tool.
- Do not touch the processor socket contacts.
- Do not tilt or slide the processor when lowering the processor into the socket.

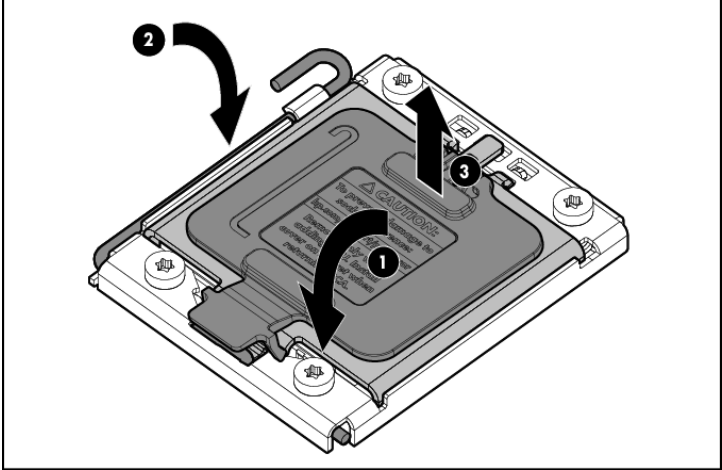
4. Press the tabs on the processor installation tool to separate it from the processor, and then remove the tool.

5. Close the processor socket retaining bracket and the processor locking lever. **The processor socket cover is automatically ejected.** Remove the cover.

Figure 19 Closing the bracket and lever, removing cover



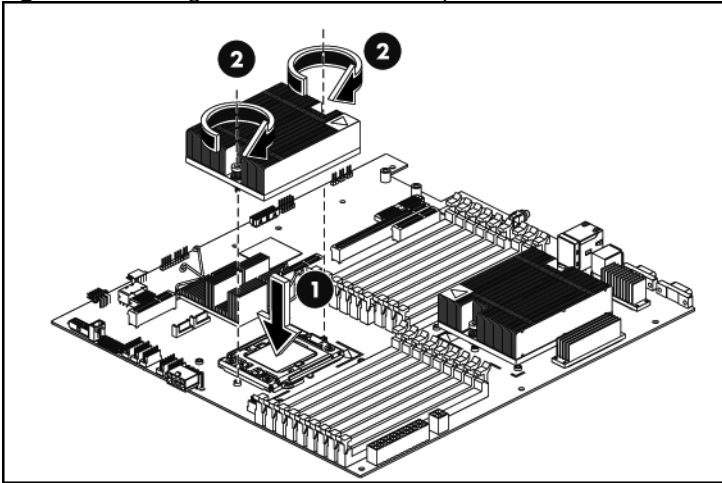
CAUTION: Be sure to close the processor socket retaining bracket before closing the processor locking lever. The lever should close without resistance. Forcing the lever closed can damage the processor and socket, requiring system board replacement.

CAUTION: HP recommends using Shin-Etsu X-23-7783D thermal grease compound for your ProLiant server. Apply the grease to the top of the processor in a 5 "Dot" pattern. Ensure even distribution.

To install the heat sink:

1. Properly align the heat sink spring-loaded screws to the system board mounting holes.
2. Tighten the spring-loaded screws clockwise to secure the heat sink connection to the system board

CAUTION: Be sure that the heat sink sits squarely on the processor, or overheating and damage to the processor may occur.

CAUTION: When installing two heat sinks, please keep the label on the heat sinks towards the T-mark guide orientation on the system board.

CAUTION: Do not over-tighten the spring-loaded screws to prevent them from breaking off. A maximum torque of 6 inch-lb is set for each screw. Rotate the heat sink a few degrees to the left and right to break the bonding of the thermal grease before removing the heat sink from the processor.

IMPORTANT: If the heat sink has been removed for any reason, it is critical that you apply more thermal interface material to the integrated heat spreader on the processor to ensure proper thermal bonding between the processor and the heat sink. Clean the contact surface of both the processor and heat sink with an alcohol pad, and then re-apply an HP-approved thermal interface material before reinstalling the processor. Use a pattern of five dots when applying the thermal interface material—one dot in the center, and one dot at each corner.

CAUTION: For proper cooling, do not operate the server without the top cover, air baffle, expansion slot covers, or blanks installed. For additional information, see the user guide. If hot-plug components are supported, minimize the amount of time the top cover is removed.
